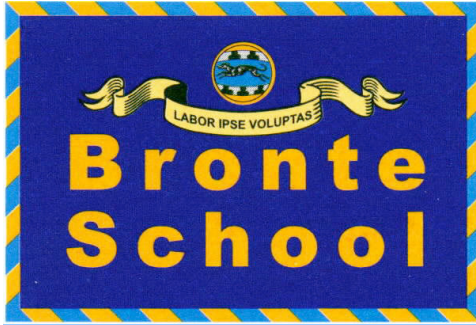




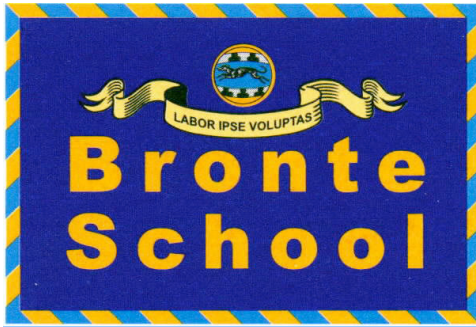

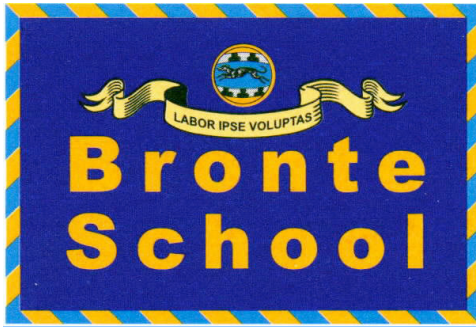

# Why Bronte?

## 1. Achievement

- Academic (small class sizes, adult:child ratios, SEN provision for both under and over-achievers, dedicated, fully qualified teaching staff, ...)
- Sporting (specialist teaching, regional/national tournaments, county players ...)
- Languages (French, German, Latin, Spanish – specialist teaching, advanced language clubs, dedicated language room/facilities)
- Music (specialist teaching, Junior choir at O<sub>2</sub> and Royal Albert Hall, Infant choir, productions, concerts, ensemble, instrumental instruction)
- Science / Design Technology (DT national awards, practical science club, Forensic Science day, dedicated, well-resourced science room & specialist teaching)
- In fact .... we believe our children achieve well in all areas of the curriculum, evidenced by the majority of pupils successfully transferring to local grammar/independent schools.

## 2. Enrichment

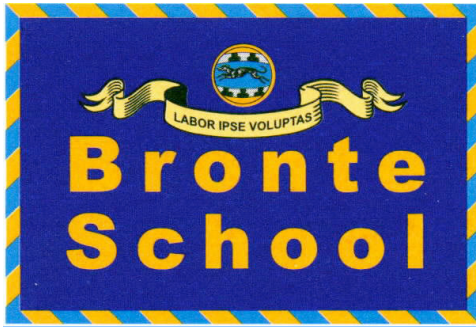
- An holistic approach – each child is seen as a ‘whole’ person with likes/dislikes and strengths/weaknesses. Everybody is valued.
- An individual approach – each child is treated individually, with their educational provision matched carefully to their needs. We DO NOT agree that ‘one size fits all’!
- Many opportunities beyond the standard curriculum to develop well-rounded individuals (eg. LAMDA-London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art-public speaking examinations, drama productions eg. Shakespeare plays/Christmas concerts, annual French trip to a Normandy chateau, visitors and visits – from steel drums to London theatre productions!)
- Resources to enrich the learning and engage our learners (ICT suite, Tuff-Cams, outside learning environment, Shakespeare 4Kids, Forest Schools... to name but a few!)

- Of the wider community – through charity work and outreach.



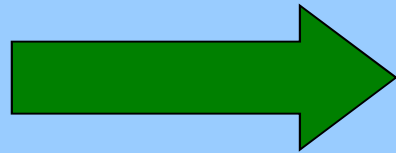

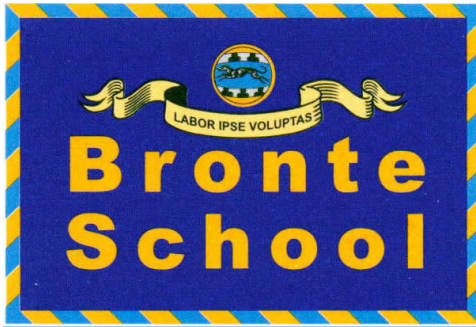
