Please buy all uniform from the official stockist to avoid variations in style, colour and fabric. Uniform purchased elsewhere may be unacceptable.

Remember to tell the stockist which is your child's class as this may make a difference to your order.

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### Winter Uniform

Winter uniform is worn in the Autumn and Spring Terms. Depending upon weather conditions, Summer uniform may be allowed for the first few weeks of the Autumn term.

#### Girls (Reception to Year 4)

Navy felt hat with band and badge (bow should go at the back)  
Navy blue tights or knee-length socks  
Navy tunic (ask stockist for the 'Bronte' tunic)  
Navy blue Bronte cardigan  
Pale blue long-sleeved shirt  
School tie (navy with gold stripe)  
Navy blue hair ribbons/bands/scrunchies or Alice Bands (available from the stockist)  
Navy blue gloves  
School scarf  
Navy blue Bronte woollen hat (for playtimes)  
Bronte navy blue school coat with logo (available only from school stockist). These should reach no longer than 2" below the knee.  
Shoes – black with laces/buckle (no ballet-style slip-ons)

**Reception class also need black wellington boots. Children in Reception Class and Year 1 may wear the ready knotted ties on elastic and kept by The Sewing Shop rather than proper ties.**

### Girls (Years 5 and 6)

As for the younger girls but a Bronte navy kilt with orange trim to be worn rather than a tunic.

### Boys (Reception to Year 6)

School cap with badge

Grey long trousers

Navy blue V-necked Bronte jumper

Pale blue long-sleeved shirt

Grey ankle socks

School scarf

Navy blue gloves

Navy blue Bronte woollen hat (for playtimes)

Bronte navy blue school coat with logo (available only from school stockist). These should reach no longer than 2" below the knee.

Shoes – black (not trainer style)

**Reception Class also need black wellington boots. Children in Reception Class and Year 1 may wear the ready knotted ties on elastic and kept by The Sewing Shop rather than proper ties.**

## Summer Uniform

### Girls (Reception to Year 4)

Yellow and white striped Bronte dress (no decorative trim)

Straw hat with band and badge (bow should go at the back)

Navy blue Bronte blazer with school badge

White ankle socks

Yellow or navy hair ribbons/bands/scrunchies only and school Alice Bands. (The Sewing Shop will make these to order in school dress fabric.)

Navy blue Bronte cardigan

Black shoes/sandals (not open toed sandals or ballet-style shoes)

Bronte sunhat (also available from the school)

### Girls (Years 5 and 6)

Bronte navy kilt (as winter uniform) and worn with short-sleeved, open neck blue shirt

Plain white ankle socks

### Boys (Reception to Year 6)

Pale blue short-sleeved shirts

School tie

Grey ankle socks

Long grey trousers (Years 3-6)



From Reception to Year 2 a Bronte School book bag is available from school. From Year 3 to Year 6 children are to have a large brown leather satchel, and should provide a pencil case with pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener, coloured pencils, whiteboard pen and glue stick.

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Girls should have long hair tied back. Boys are expected to have a conventional hairstyle (e.g. no designer stripes).

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NO jewellery except a watch and ear studs (where worn) for reasons of safety. Ear studs must be removed for P.E. and games and the child is responsible for doing this. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.

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It would be appreciated if children could be taught to tie their own shoelaces and tie as soon as possible.

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**Parents are advised to order items from the Sewing Shop in advance whenever possible. We recommend at least half a term in advance for personalized and expensive items. Ordered items may be delivered to the school by request.**
